



## COVID19 GUIDELINES



# Weston Farmers' Market

During the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic, Farmers Markets are permitted to continue if they follow the guidelines recommended by regional and provincial health guidelines. The following procedures were made in reference to the COVID-19 Guidance for Farmers', Fresh Food & Holiday Markets from Toronto Public Health last updated April 14<sup>th</sup> 2021.

### Protocols for Vendors & Staff

- All staff will be **actively screened for COVID-19** upon arrival at the market.
- Vendors are required to have their own **hand washing station** and sanitizer.
- Vendors are **required to wear a mask or face covering** when interacting with customers.
- Vendors are **required to use physical barriers** at point of contact with the customer.
- Vendors are encouraged to offer **contactless payment** options.
- Vendors are **not permitted to offer samples**.
- Booths shall maintain at least **2m distance** between themselves and another vendor.
- Vendors shall **discourage direct handling** of products by customers and manage lineups.

### Protocols for Guests

- Signage will be posted at the entrance of the market for guests to **self screen for COVID-19**.
- Anyone feeling ill should **NOT** visit the market.
- **Hand sanitizer** will be available for guests to use throughout the market.
- Guests should try their best to maintain a **social distance of 2m** between another guest.
- Guests are strongly encouraged to **wear a mask or face covering at all times inside the market**.
- The maximum capacity of the market shall be **98 people at one-time**.
- There will be a **one-way flow** of pedestrian traffic within the market, with one entrance and one exit.
- There is **no eating or drinking** within the market.
- Guests will be asked to **avoid lingering** in one area once they have completed your purchase.
- Staff have the right to ask any guest to leave the market if they are not following the above guidelines or directions from market staff or volunteers.
