WHO DO I CALL?

9-1-1

Call 9-1-1 for a police, fire or medical emergency

- Person with a weapon
- Person in Crisis (i.e. someone is a danger to themselves and/or others)
- Medical event or overdose

- Fighting or assault in progress
- Fire
- Active Theft or Vandalism
- · Active Break and Enter

Non-Emergency Line

Call 416-808-2222 if you need to report to police for a non-emergent matter

- Illegal parking matters
- Unhoused person on private property
- Drug/Alcohol use in public spaces (benches, parks)
- Hate-related graffiti found
- Inactive Break and Enters

2-1-1

Call 2-1-1 for a referral to Community or Social Services

- Mental Health Crisis
- Wellness Checks

- Intoxicated person
- Unhoused person on public property

3-1-1

Call 3-1-1 for a city services support request

- Fallen/Damaged Trees
- Full or overflowing garbage cans
- Cleaning of debris from sidewalks
- Illegal dumping
- Feeding of wildlife
- Littering

- Grass and Weed Maintenance on public property
- Non-emergency animal complaints
- Noise complaints
- Smoking complaints
